Getting to Queen's Medical Library

Many of the dentistry, medical, midwifery and nursing books and journals that you will need to read during your course are kept in the Medical Library, in the Mulhouse Building at the Royal Victoria Hospital (RVH). The Medical Library is close to the QUB Institute of Clinical Sciences, and also the School of Dentistry, where you might have some lectures. Car parking at RVH can be difficult, so why not travel to the Medical Library by shuttle bus, or by Metro?


Belfast Trust shuttle bus



A **free** shuttle bus service, provided by Belfast Health and Social Care Trust, runs between Belfast City Hospital (BCH), close to the MBC, and the Royal Maternity Hospital at RVH, a short walk from the Medical Library.

QUB students can use this bus – show your student card to the driver if asked.

Travelling from BCH to RVH:



The shuttle bus runs throughout the day, Monday to Friday. The timetable is below:

Several Metro buses pass the Medical Library. These depart from near Belfast City Hall, so you'll first need to get into the city centre – the buses below all run from QUB into the centre:

- 7A/B (board on Botanic Avenue)
- 8 A/B (board outside Student Union)
- 9 A/B (board on Lisburn Road)

From the city centre, catch any of these buses towards the Royal Victoria Hospital:
